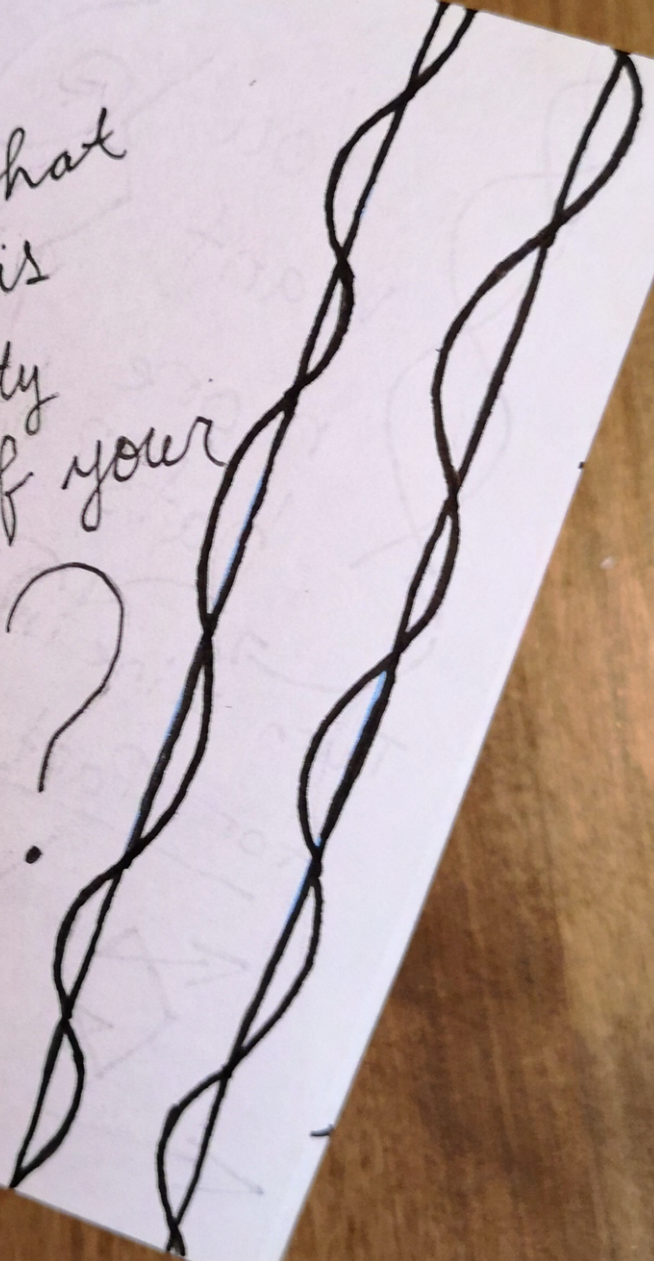
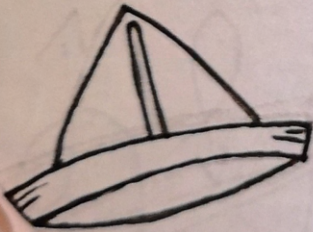

To answer this, I have to circle back to the idea of productivity. I have this bucket list goal to write a book, and each year I don't accomplish that...

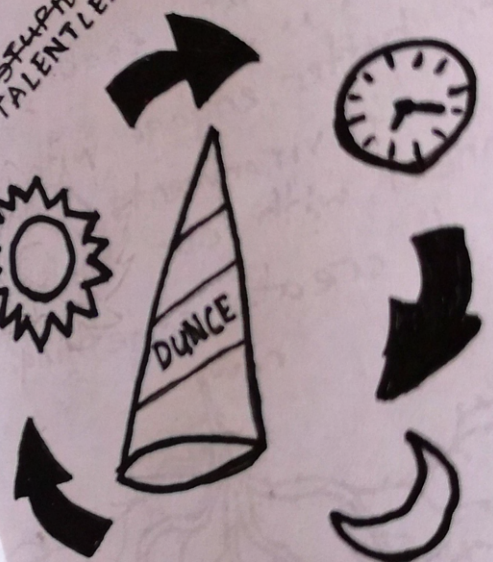
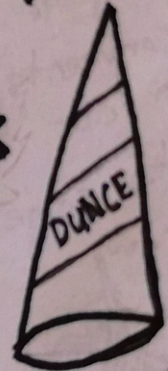
Maybe. I can't afford the hat I need?

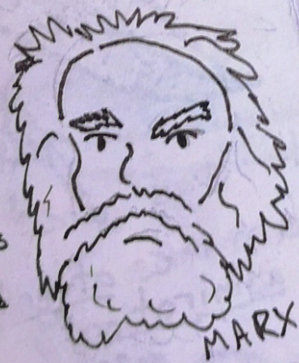


Freud and Marx both had NOT-SEXY definitions for fetish.
